

Iowa State USBC Youth Championship Tournament

Guidelines for Hosting Associations

- To be eligible to host the Iowa State USBC Youth Championship Tournament an association must have a minimum of four (4) teams participating in the three (3) previous consecutive years of the tournament. If unable to meet this requirement the tournament may be awarded to another association
- Hosting centers must meet the required number of certified lanes: 24 for single center or 12/20 when using two centers
- Must offer multiple shifts daily
- Centers must be well maintained and handicap accessible, including restrooms
- Lineage is negotiable using the hosts' previous three (3) year average
- Hosting association must provide qualified office helpers and score monitors as needed to ensure all tournament operations and procedures are handled in a timely and efficient manner.
- Center(s) shall provide an area for the tournament office and photography.
- Center(s) shall provide complimentary shoes as a courtesy to youth needing shoes.
- Center(s) shall provide conditions compliant with USBC lane dressing requirements and consistent with the tournament contract.
- Hosting association/local CVB shall secure a host hotel and list of hotels offering special rate for bowlers.
- Complimentary hotel room for the Youth Coordinator/Tournament Director on Friday and Saturday for duration of the tournament.

Selection of the tournament site shall be made from qualified bids by the Youth Committee subject to approval by the Iowa State Board of Directors. If an association is unwilling or unable to meet the above criteria the Iowa State USBC President and/or Youth Coordinator may select another site with approval of the Iowa State USBC Board of Directors.
